



This photograph was taken Saturday, March 25, 2017, at a reception following the service at **Washington National Cathedral** at which friends, admirers, and loved ones commemorated the life and legacy of **EUSTACE EDWARD RICARDO (“TED”) BRAITHWAITE**, who was born on June 27, 1912, in Guyana and died on December 12, 2016, a short distance from his D. C. residence at the age of 104.
