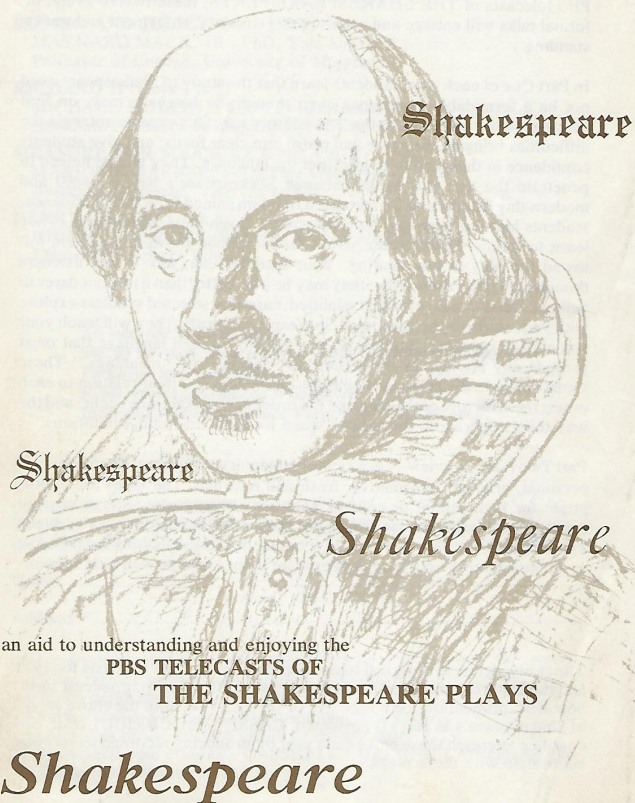

Listeners followed the play in one hearing. Your students can, too — bad listeners though some may seem to be, they may be a lot better than a teacher dares to believe. Let our team of highly qualified, carefully selected scholars explore with your students the aspects of Shakespeare's craft. They will teach your students to recognize the signals given them through language that must precede any attempt to try to sum up "themes" or "meanings." These signals include the language itself; the characters and their relation to each other; the structure of the play and the order in which actions occur; and the way things operate in the theater when we have real actors before us.

Part Two is an overview — a critical commentary of the play. Each lecture is personal, original, imaginative, fresh and informal. The tapes are appropriate for high school or college level use although they are in no way restricted to classroom use and do not require the listener to have previous knowledge of the play. Lively and spontaneous, these lectures could serve as an introductory course to Shakespeare in the home as well as in school.
