


In Commemoration of James G. McManaway, 1899-1980

HAKESPEAREANS AROUND THE WORLD lost one of their dearest friends when James G. Mednanway died in Las Vegas on November 9. Dr. McManaway, who was 81, had moved to the Nevada home of his on two years earlier after failing health had



made it impossible for him to continue living at his residence in Chevy Chase, Maryland. Editor, textual expert, literary historian, library administrator, consultant, and teacher, James McManaway was one of the most influential and revered scholars of his generation. Born in Fayette, Missouri, on August 24, 1899, he was educated at the University

of Virginia (B.A., 1919, M.A., 1920) and at Johns Hopkins University (Ph.D., 1931).
